### **The Physics of the Clarinet - Huffman Coding**

The clarinet, in the simplest possible explanation, is a pipe with a reed on one end and a bell on the other The reed vibrates and creates the sound, the holes change the wavelength of the note, and the bell directs the sound waves Its origins are in the German chalumeau, a recorder-like instrument first played in the medieval ages
